# **SCHOOL LUNCH**

Breakfast is offered at the Memorial Early Childhood Center, Henry B. Burkland School, Mary K. Goode School, John T. Nichols, Jr. Middle School and Middleborough High School each morning.

If your child was eligible for a free or reduced lunch last year, then eligibility will remain in effect through the end of September or until this year's applications have been reviewed.

Middleborough Public Schools utilizes a point-of-sales system for lunch purposes. Please help your child to remember their 4-digit pin which was assigned in June. Families may pay for lunches online at MyNutrikids.com. There is a link on the school website.

### SCHOOL OPENING INFORMATION

#### MARY K. GOODE SCHOOL AND BURKLAND SCHOOL PARKING

A great challenge confronting students and parents on the first few days of school is traffic congestion. On these days the increased volume of traffic requires a **no parking** ban on Mayflower Avenue during the **arrival** of students. Parents and others visiting the schools on the first three days will be asked to park elsewhere and not on Mayflower Avenue. Arrangements have been made to provide temporary parking during the first three days at Middleborough Crossing (Hannaford Plaza) on Route 28. Please use East and West Grove Streets as the means of accessing this parking. Avoiding South Main Street will ease frustrations and also prevent traffic congestion at the intersection of Route 105 and Route 28. The Middleborough Police Department will have an officer on duty at Middleborough Crossing to allow parents and students to safely cross Route 28. After the first three days of school, starting on Monday, September 12, 2011, students arriving to school must be dropped off on the Mayflower Avenue side of the Mary K. Goode and Henry B. Burkland Schools.

Another reminder is that for safety reasons the <u>dismissal</u> of Mary K. Goode School and Henry B. Burkland School students to school bus transportation takes place on the Mayflower Avenue side of the schools. Pickup of students by parents and/or guardians at <u>dismissal</u> time is done on the Route 28 side of the Mary K. Goode and Henry B. Burkland Schools.

It is the policy of the Middleboro Public Schools to adhere to Massachusetts General Law and Massachusetts Department of Public Health Immunization Requirements for school entry.

Massachusetts state law requires all students to be fully immunized before attending school. The only exceptions to this law are documented religious objections OR a physician verified exemption due to medical reasons.

A physical exam within one year prior to entering KINDERGARTEN and no later than thirty (30) days after entering is also required. Thereafter, a report of physical exam should be submitted prior to entry into grades three, seven and nine. ALL students new to or returning to the Middleboro Public School system must also submit documentation of a physical exam within the last year and no later than thirty (30) days after entrance.

PLEASE SEND THE REQUESTED PHYSICIAN DOCUMENTATION TO YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL NURSE IMMEDIATELY SO THAT YOUR CHILD MAY BEGIN SCHOOL ON OPENING DAY IN SEPTEMBER. BY STATE LAW, STUDENTS MAY NOT ATTEND SCHOOL IF THEY DO NOT PROVIDE PROOF OF REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS AND PHYSICAL EXAM.

School nurses will be available at each school on Tuesday, September 6, 2011 from 1-3PM to meet with parents.

As always, please contact your child's school with questions or concerns. The health and safety of all our students continues to be a priority for the Middleboro Public Schools.

### **ATHLETIC FEES**

Athletic user fees for fall sport athletes at Middleborough High School are due by Friday, September 2, 2011. Single sport fees for the 2011-2012 school year are \$175.

All payments may be made any time prior to the September 2, 2011 deadline and must be made in full as installments payments are not possible. Payments must be made via bank check or money order only.
